The categories are: CAKES & PIES. The cake category will include Layer, Bundt and Sheet. The pie category will include all pies. Cheesecake IS A PIE. (The entry must be able to be sliced, not scooped.) Please remember that **NO FORM OF ALCOHOL** is to be used in either cake or pie entries.

All cakes and pies must be homemade. No store bought entry will be allowed and must be accompanied by a recipe. Each entry into the State finals must furnish a copy of these recipes by **October 19, 2024**. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

Auxiliary competitions should take place before October 12, 2024. Only the first place winner in each category may proceed to the State level.

Prizes to be awarded on the auxiliary level are at the discretion of each auxiliary. Prizes on the State level will be awarded for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , & 3^{rd} places in each category.

Names of the Auxiliary winners, along with the \$15.00 entry fee per winner, and two (2) copies of the winners' recipes must be submitted no later than **October 19, 2024**, so arrangements can be made for space and tables. **DO NOT PUT THE NAME OF THE WINNER OR THE AUXILIARY ON THE RECIPE**.

All participants are asked to register with the State Chairperson the morning of the event **NO LATER THAN 8:45 A.M.** as the **JUDGING WILL BEGIN PROMPTLY AT 9:00 A.M**. I trust all auxiliaries will participate in this delicious competition.

LLAA BAKE TASTE CONTEST RULES

ALL LEVELS

- 1. Cake will be made from either a cake mix or your own recipe.
- 2. Cake will be made by an INDIVIDUAL ONLY, who shall enter the contest under her own name.
- 3. Cake shape, size and looks will left up to the individual.
- 4. Cake or pie must be able to be sliced (not scooped). This means they must be able to be cut not spooned out.
- 5. Pie must have a bottom crust and may or may not have a side or top crust.
- 6. Cake or pie must be baked at home and transported to designated location at each level.
- 7. Each individual will assume the cost of the cake or pie.
- 8. The same recipe is to be used by the individual at all levels.
- 9. Cakes and/or pies will be judged on TASTE ONLY.
- 10. There will be three (3) judges appointed at the local level and six (6) at the State Level. [Three (3) for cakes and (3) for pies.]
- 11. Pies may use a store bought crust.
- 12. Only one cake or pie per person will be allowed.
- 13. Judges are the responsibility of the hosting auxiliary.
- 14. Prizes will be given on State Level as follows:
 - A. CAKES (this includes all type of cakes except cheesecakes which are considered pies)
 - B. PIES

1st, 2nd and 3rd places will be given in each category
